- Be the key link between Engineering and the Integrated Supply Chain for change order management. Be a driver in new product introduction initiatives and obsolescence management, tracking key milestones to enable successful execution of the program.
- Interact with the Demand Managers to ensure factory visibility to forecasted customer demand.
- Review long-term forecasts with factories to identify and mitigate possible capacity/material issues analyzing rough-cut capacity plans for each factory and recommend appropriate action.
